NEW BULK TRASH PICK UP SCHEDULE FOR 2018

Bulk Trash Pick Up will be every 5 weeks beginning October 1, 2018

Serrano is still located in Zone B

Trash and Recycling pick up is still on Tuesday

Bulk pick up until the end of the year dates will be November 12th & December 31st

<u>Household trash is not accepted for bulk pick up and</u> should be bagged and placed in your trash container.

Items should be placed out for collection **no earlier** than the Saturday prior to your collection week
and **no later** than 5:00 AM on Monday of your
collection week. Pickup may occur any day during your
collection week. Please watch for the signs at each
entry way to put out your bulk trash.
