NEW BULK TRASH PICK UP SCHEDULE FOR 2021

Bulk Trash Pick Up will be every 5 weeks

Serrano is still located in Zone B

Trash and Recycling pick up is still on Tuesday

Bulk pick up for the first half of the year dates will be:

February 1st, March 8th, April 12th, May 17th &

June 21st

Household trash is not accepted for bulk pick up and should be bagged and placed in your trash container.

Items should be placed out for collection **no earlier** than the Saturday prior to your collection week and **no later** than 5:00 AM on Monday of your collection week. Pickup may occur any day during your collection week. Please watch for the signs at each entry way to put out your bulk trash.

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Be Responsible With Your Pets

Please know that pets must be leashed when walking within the community grounds, as it is required of the City of Gilbert as well as the Serrano CC&R's. **Be respectful by picking up after your pet on common grounds and all neighboring property. It is so sad seeing dog waste left in homeowner's front yards and them not being dog owners.**

Safety

Please be careful walking and leaving your pets outside at night. There have been several Coyote and Owl sighting throughout the Gilbert area. I have personally sighted a big coyote in our green belt area on my walks in the early mornings. There is a large Owl roaming the community looking for small prey as well.

When walking in the early morning while it is still dark or late-night walking be alert of your surrounding of strange cars or people within the community.
